SECTION: 1 – TENDER INVITATION

1.1 Invitation

- ✓ Mysuru Wildlife Division, Mysuru , invites competitive tenders in two covers from reputed firms who have proven experience in implementation of similar works.
- ✓ Bidders are advised to study the invitation document carefully.
- ✓ The Invitation document can be downloaded from the e-procurement portal of Government of Karnataka website. (<http://eproc.karnataka.gov.in>) (Selection of Department: Forest Department)

1.2 Procurement of Tender Document

Bidder can download the tender document from the portal till the due date and time for bid submission.

- ✓ Bidder shall pay online, the tender processing fee as notified by e-portal and EMD of ₹ 25,000.00 (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only).
- ✓ The Bidder shall ensure credit of Tender Processing Fee & EMD into the respective receiving bank accounts of e-Procurement, Department of e-Governance, Govt. of Karnataka on or before the last date of bid submission.
- ✓ Please note that payments submitted through cheque or demand draft shall not be accepted. Further details regarding e-Payment and helpline, please refer to e-Procurement portal at the above mentioned website.

SECTION : 2 - SCOPE OF WORK

2.1 Introduction

Ranganathittu Bird Sanctuary is one of the well known bird sanctuary in sanctuaries of India . It is situated in Srirangapattana Taluk of Mandya District. This sanctuary comprises of 6 (six) Islands and 6 (six) Islets in the river Cauvery. The Islets are the main breeding ground for variety of local and migratory birds. It was built between 1645 and 1648, when Kantirava Narasaraja Wodeyar was the Ruler of Mysore.

Ranganathittu Bird Sanctuary was declared as a Sanctuary on 1st July 1940 vide GO No.A.F/19/FT/293-39-40 by General & Revenue Secretariat, Bangalore under the Government of His Highness the Maharaja of Mysore. Later final notification of Ranganathittu Bird Sanctuary was issued vide GO No. A.F/19 /FT/293/39-40 dated:1.9.1998 by the Government of Karnataka.

The sanctuary is very close to Mysore city and historical place of Srirangapattana which are also tourist places themselves and lie close to Mysore – Bangalore highway.

Over 221 species of birds have been reported from sanctuary and surrounding areas over period of time. The sanctuary is a very popular bird watching destination in the south visits annually more than **3.50 lakhs** visitors including Indians and foreigners.

At present tourist facility has been provided at Ranganathittu which includes light and heavy vehicle parking places, paragolas, gardens, wet land garden, drinking water facility, toilet, canteen, Interpretation Centre and boating facility to go round the islets and islands.

The main objectives of the Souvenir Shop at Ranganathittu Bird Sanctuary are to impart conservation education and to create awareness for wildlife conservation to the children/visitors.

In order to instill interest about wildlife conservation among sanctuary visitors and to carry a souvenir in memory of their visit to the sanctuary .

2.3 Scope of Project

The project involves supply of quality Fiber Boats with all its accessories and safety features.

SCHEDULE

Supply of Fiber Rowing Boats & Accessories with seating capacity of 15-18 persons and following specifications.

A. Dimensions:-

Length : 8.00 to 9.00 m
Breadth : 1.75 to 2.00 m
Depth: 0.85m
Seating capacity : 15 to 18 persons.

B. Construction :

The boat should be built by using fiber glass mat and isophthalic resin. These materials should have the approval of classification society. The boat builder has to indicate the sequence of lay up of mat. At least 8 layers of chopped strand mat and woven roving are to be used. The hull thickness should be at least 8mm. The bottom portion of the hull is to be given three more layers of fiber glass mat. The bottom is to be stiffened in the athwart ship direction as well as longitudinal directions using hat section stiffeners of size **100mm x 75mm and at least 4mm thick**. The spacing of the stiffeners should be **500mm**. The stiffeners are required to be filled up with foam and over the stiffeners, a marine plywood floor of 9 mm thickness is required to be provided and bonded to the hull. The hollow space between the floors and the hull bottom is required to be filled with polyurethane foam. The hull should be of double skin to give a smooth finish both inside and outside.

- C. **Deck:** A half deck at the forward end is to be provided constructed from FRP along with gunwale. The deck is to be permanently bonded to the hull. Storage space for accessories is to be provided under the deck.
- D. **Windscreen (Optional):** A Windscreen is to be fitted to the deck. FRP frame work covered with acrylic transparent glass for visibility and protection against wind and water spray is to be provided.
- E. **Seating :** Seating arrangement is to be provided for accommodating 15 to 18 persons comfortably. The seats will be made bench form with provision for Boatman/Rowing.
- F. **Canopy Roof:** it should be made with fiber glass material and fitted with metal frame work.

SECTION: 3 - INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS (ITB)

3.1 Validity of Tender

Tender shall remain valid for a period of 90 (ninety) days from the date of opening of tender.

3.2 Right to accept or Reject Tenders

The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Wildlife Division, Mysuru, reserves its right to annul the tender process or to accept or reject any or all the tenders in whole or part at any time, without assigning any reasons and without incurring any liability to the affected Company(s), or any obligation to inform the affected Company(s) of the grounds for such decision.

3.3 Fraud and Corruption

It is required that the firm submitting tender and the firm short listed through this Tender must observe the highest standards of ethics during the process of short listing of Company and during the RFP process.

The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Wildlife Division, Mysuru will declare a firm ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, for participation in bid, if it at any time determines that the firm has engaged in corrupt, fraudulent and unfair trade practices in competing for, or in executing, the contract.

3.4 Clarifications and amendments of Tender

- A. During process of the evaluation of the tender, Deputy Conservator of Forests, Wildlife Division, Mysuru may, at its discretion, ask the agency/firm/company for clarifications on their tender. The agency/firm/company is required to respond within the prescribed time frame.
- B. Deputy Conservator of Forests, Wildlife Division, Mysuru may for any reason, modify the tender terms and conditions from time to time and shall be published in the e-portal. The amendment(s) to the tender would be clearly spelt out and the agency/firm/company shall amend their tender due to such amendments, before the last date for submission.
- C. Bidders are advised to check e-procurement website regularly for any Addendum/ Corrigendum/ Amendments related to the Project.

3.5 Process and Stages

STAGE - I: Short listing based about technical points:

- A. Submission of technical Proposal:** The bidder shall submit their tender – technical proposal over the e-procurement portal as mentioned above on or before the given date for receipt of tender. Every page of the document submitted by the Company must be duly signed by the authorized signatory of the firm along with the firm seal before uploading onto the portal.
- B. Preliminary Scrutiny:** Preliminary scrutiny of the tender for eligibility will be done to determine whether the agency/firm/company will qualify the eligibility criteria specified in the document. In this context, the Lowest bidder shall be intimated to produce original documents for verification.
- C. Short listing:** Agency/firm/Companies will be short listed by evaluation on the basis of the technical documents, capability, competence & proposed approach, etc. and the same will be intimated by Deputy Conservator of Forests, Wildlife Division, Mysuru.

STAGE - II:

Selection of successful bidder amongst short listed agency/company based on commercial bids.

- A. Submission of commercial Proposal:** After furnishing technical proposal along with required documents in the e-procurement portal, the bidder has to offer in the e-portal Ruppes .
- B. Selection of agency:** Commercial bids of only the short listed technical bidders, shall be opened on the specified date or afterwards, and after preliminary scrutiny, the Bidder/Agency quoting the lowest cost per unit shall be selected and intimated in due course and time.

3.6 PRE-QUALIFICATION FOR TENDER PARTICIPATION

Tenders are invited from those Company/firms who meet the following pre-qualification criteria and submit the documents in e-portal:

- A. Certificate of registration of agency/firm/company and profile.
- B. The bidders should submit audited financial statements for the years 2015-16 to 2017-18 and minimum turnover in the recent financial year i.e. for 2017-18 should be ₹ **50.00 lakhs** .
- C. The bidder should have experience in supply of Boats to government departments. Certificates from minimum three such institutions should be submitted.
- D. Copy of PAN card and copies of acknowledgement of annual returns filed for the financial years 2015-16-2017-18.
- E. Copy of GST certificate and copies of acknowledgement of returns filed for the month of financial year 2017-18.

The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Wildlife Division, Mysuru. reserves the right to carry out the capability assessment of the Company and the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Wildlife Division, Mysuru. decision shall be final in this regard.

The firm/Company who fails to meet these criteria or who do not submit requisite supporting proof as specified in Formats, is liable to be rejected during preliminary scrutiny.

3.9 Other conditions:

- 1) The selected firm should supply of fiber boats only the approved quality .
- 2) If the applying firm is a branch, then authorization letter from the head office to be provided.
- 3) The rates quoted by the tenderer is inclusive of all taxes and transportation cost to Ranganathittu Bird Sanctuary.
- 4) The participants in the tender must be a Manufacturer / Distributor of the Boats and attach the copies of the relevant record in this regard
- 5) The bidder is required to furnish **Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs.25,000.00 (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only)** through e-portal of Karnataka Government.
- 6) The Earnest Money Deposit of the Bidders will be refunded after finalization of tenders.
- 7) The successful Bidder shall deliver to the undersigned a Security deposit through Demand draft in favor of Deputy Conservator of Forests, Wildlife Division, Mysuru for an amount **Rs 1.00 lakhs (Rupees One lakh only)** before executing the Agreement.
- 8) The successful bidder shall execute an agreement on stamp paper of requisite value and comply with the provisions of the Indian Stamp Act, 1989 and related Court Fee and Valuation Acts and the rules made there under as amended from time to time.
- 9) The Security Deposit will be refunded without any interest after satisfactory completion of the contract period. If any dues either to this division or government shall be adjusted out of security deposit.
- 10) The boat will be provided with two pairs to wooden oars oar locks and thwarts to seat 18 passengers
- 11) IRS approved 18 Nos of Life Jackets & 2 life Buoy & 01 torch must be supplied.

- 12) Conditional tenders are liable to be rejected. The officer competent to accept the tender shall have the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- 13) All necessary permits, General license etc., which will be required, if any are to be obtained from the supplier themselves.
- 14) Terms of payment- 100% of the invoice value will be paid after satisfactory inspection, testing and receipt of the location designated by Deputy conservator of Forests, Wildlife Division, Mysore.
- 15) Liquidated damages:-The boats are to be deliver in the time period as specified in the Tender Documents. Any delay will lead to a penalty of 1% per week are part thereof. In case the delay exceed 15 days from the delivery date the Deputy conservator of Forests, Wildlife Division, Mysore has the rights to cancel the order and claim the loss incurred from the boat supplier
- 16) The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Wildlife Division, Mysuru will have powers to forfeit security deposit in part or full in the event of failure by the Company/firm to fulfill the terms and conditions of the contract, satisfactorily.
- 17) Procedure for Resolution of disputes:
 - ✓ Any disputes, differences or controversy of whatever nature between the parties, howsoever arising under, out of or in relation to the contract agreement, shall in the first instance be attempted to be resolved amicably by meeting between the parties.
 - ✓ Any dispute which is not amicably resolved by the parties of the contract, shall be finally settled by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Mysuru Circle, Mysuru, whose decision shall be final and binding on both the parties.
 - ✓ Pending submission of and / or decision on a dispute, the parties shall continue to perform their respective obligations under the contract agreement without prejudice to a final adjustment
- 18) In the interest of Sanctuary, the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Wildlife Division, Mysuru reserves the right to add, modify or delete any of the terms and conditions related to this contract before finalization of tender or during contract period.

GUARANTEE PERIOD:

- 19) The Guarantee Period for all the components of works done and supplied under this contract shall be 1 Year . The Guarantee Period will be reckoned from the date of satisfactory completion of work. The repairs, rectification and defects etc., if any, arises during the guarantee period shall be attended and made good by the supplier without any extra cost to Deputy Conservator of Forests, Wildlife Division, Mysuru.

PRICE VARIATION:

- 20) No price variation will be allowed for materials. The excess or less percentage quoted by the contractor shall be firm and binding upon the contractor till the work is completed. The quoted percentage less/excess on binding on the bidder even for award of part work.
